

- V. New Business
  - A. S.R. 04 030 Can't Ban Us 2.0
    - i. Sen. Vogel read the resolution.
    - ii. Opening statement:
      - 1. Sen. Lachapelle: the previous resolution was in response to enacted legislating, student advocacy group participated in drafting the resolution, there is a statistically significant increase in violence and harassment, the bill is holistic and focuses on student health and wellness. The anti-LGBTQ laws affect younger individuals and their daily lives.
    - iii. Sen. Vogel: there are precedents with this type of legislation, resolution is helpful for support and providing safe spaces for LGBTQ students.
    - iv. 5 min Q&A: Sen. Cambron: asks to explain the difference between Pride Center and Pride Student Union
    - v. Sen. Lachapelle: clarified the difference.
    - vi. 10-min discussion:
      - 1. Sen. Stone: appreciates the sponsors for reaching out to students and the way the bill breaks down the causes for being presented, fully supports the bill.
      - 2. Sen. Brochinsky: supports the bill as well, had a panel with hotel general managers about perspectives of being foreign nationals, shares the same perspective regarding identity.



- 3. Sen. Young: likes the awareness in the resolution.
- 4. Sen. Sharma: expresses appreciation for the sponsors, discusses the appropriate timeline for introducing gender topics for children.
- 5. Sen. Lachapelle: Don't Say Gay bill was taken to court, children should not be pressured, children are aware about their identity at an early age, communication ways are not the same for children of different ages, the intention is to show escalation and progression of bills.
- 6. Sen. Young: gender matters are present in the world and should be taught through education.
- 7. Sen. Brochinsky: it takes education to learn more about oneself, should be taught at an earlier stage than college education.
