The Student Government Association hosted hearings and deliberations for the allocation of the FY 2018-2019 Activity and Service revenue. The Student Government Association has done its best to fund entities in a sufficient manner so that they can effectively aid us in reaching FIU's goals. It is our opinion that these allocations reflect the most efficient avenues by which to meet the growing demand of the student population as well as address the university's strategic goals.

The Student Government Association again this year faced requests that outweighed the Activity and Services fee projected revenue. This year proved to be more difficult than usual because of the change in the percentage (%) split between both the campus. Leaving 80% for MMC and 20% for BBC which is 6% lesser than previous years for BBC. That has put BBC in a very difficult place to be able to deliver the same quality of events/services that they have been delivering in the past.

We made every attempt to continue the 2017-18 commitment to fund positions that subsequently transitioned out of the Division of Student Affairs despite having challenges funding needs and initiatives in our own division. Despite these challenges, we feel that we succeeded in our mission this year by analyzing and exploring the services offered by each requesting entity to determine the highest impact to student services, quality and value.

We hope that you also will find these allocations sufficient for servicing the needs of the student body. We eagerly await formal approval of the additional FY 18-19 budget within 15 days of being presented. Pursuant the 2017 Florida Statute the budget will be deemed approved if no action is taken within 15 school days from the date it is received by you. Thank you for your guidance throughout this process. The Student Government Association applauds your efforts and looks forward to working with you in the coming year.

University Wide Proviso Language 2018-2019

- Black Student Union: \$12,000 must be given to BBC Vice President for programming at BBC. At least 25% of the BSU programs must occur at BBC.
- (2) Center for Leadership and Service: \$4,000 from the CLS budget must be used for the changemaker initiatives. Leadership summit must be planned in collaboration with the LEAD team. \$6,000 for the Student Food Pantry must remain in the ASBO account to be administered by the ASBO office, for food pantry only. Allocated funds should not go to increase the LEAD Team stipends.
- (3) FIU in DC: FIU in DC must stay within SGA account and must be administered by concurrence of both SGA Presidents.
- (4) International Student and Scholar Services (ISSS): ISSS will not receive A&S funding other than the current two salaried positions beyond this allocation and should look for funding elsewhere.
- (5) MPAS: A&S funds can't be used for the MLK breakfast or any other programming that is not open to all students. LGBTQA initiatives must receive \$30,000 in a unique activity number for that purpose.
- (6) Office of Student Access & Success: The funding for this position shall be allocated to the Dean of Students office for a Success Coach whom shall report to the Dean of Students and shall work in collaboration with the Office of Student Access and Success.
- (7) Panther Luau: Panther Luau needs to increase marketing University wide.
- (8) Room Rental University Wide: SGA must receive a monthly report on usage and amount spent. If there are any unused balance at the end of the fiscal year, it shall be carried forward in the same category for this purpose. SGA Presidents and Comptrollers need to be involved in ongoing discussions on how to implement the budget distribution.
- (9) SGA Intern Program: SGA Intern program to be moved to campus specific.
- (10) Student Ambassadors: Student Ambassadors shall become a university wide agency of SGA and must abide by all SGA policies. The Student Ambassador President shall be appointed by the concurrence of the SGA Presidents after the Student Ambassador Eboard submits a recommendation for the position. The Student Ambassador advisor shall be a staff member from FIU University Advancement.
- (11) Student Conduct and Conflict Resolution: SCCR must create educational videos for students and student organizations to better understand the new code of conduct.
- (12) Student Media: Student Media shall have its budget breakdown readily accessible to all students especially its members.
- (13) University Wide Leadership: Change name of the University Leadership Retreat to SGA Leadership Retreat. If the event cannot be held at an offsite location, any unused funds will revert to the University Wide Contingency.

Modesto Maidique Campus Proviso Language 2018-2019

- (1) Fraternity and Sorority Life: Council of Executive Boards must approve expenditures of their budgets by the concurrence of the majority of their membership present with quorum. Fraternity and Sorority Life must provide a quarterly report on all auxiliaries (fees and fines) to SGA.
- (2) MultiFaith Council: By October 1, 2018 Multifaith must create an executive board of students elected by its members. \$500 must be reserved to expend by the board to promote the Multifaith Council. The SGA comptroller will work with Multifaith during the following budget cycle.
- (3) Office of Veteran and Military Affairs: The Office of Veteran and Military Affairs must provide student veterans free printing and must work with the SGA cabinet members. The Veteran's breakfast must be open and advertised to all students and must be called the SGA Veterans Breakfast.
- (4) Residence Hall Association: No more than \$3,000 can be used for conferences and Hall Councils must receive at least \$1,500 each.
- (5) Student Programming Council: SPC must hold 10% of programs at the Engineering Center.

Proviso for Base Budget: Base funded for three years with adjustments for University mandated salary increases.
