 - A. Jacqueline Canut (BBC Lieutenant Governor): Not present, tabled for now
 - X. Unfinished Business
 - A. SR 03 014: Can't Ban Us + 15 Minute Discussion:
 - B. Sen Rodriguez: Confused because when we did read it last time it was not an offical "first read".
 - C. Pro Temp Stangl: The "first read" is when a piece of legislation is sent via email within 48 hours in advance. This is because it was sent out Saturday
 - D. Sen Moya Palacios: If there is a 15 minute discussion how much time is given to each person.
 - E. Pro Temp Stengl: People will be allowed to talk until the 15 minutes are up.
 - F. 15 Minute discussion:
 - G. Sen Tunon: Fully in favor for this bill. Has read the updated version and sees no problem with it.
 - H. Sen Columna: Its a weak argument to go against CRT or just ban anything we do not agree with.
 - I. Sen Moya Palacios: Freedom of Speech is under attack. Supports the "cantbanus" act.
 - J. Sen Jusino: Started the petition against the "cantbanus" act. Made the petition because not every person's viewpoint is in like with the "cantbanus" act. We must acknowledge other peoples viewpoint's and not be immediately put down.
 - K. Sen LaChapelle: There seems to be confusion on this bill. The petition against the bill has only recieved 33 signatures. We are not trying to force our ideology on anyone; we're just trying to show we exist.
 - L. Sen Cicconi: Has visited the Adam Smith center and has always been a great place to express ideas. I'm not going to call myself a victim and urges all senators to vote "no" on this bill. This bill is divisive.
 - M. Sen King: If you are voting down this bill you are not listening to the students.
 - N. MOTION: Sen Rodriguez: Extend this discussion by 5 minutes. MOTION PASSES
 - O. Sen Rodriguez: Voting in support of this bill is supporting the international aspect of FIU. We continue to break records and advancing because we respect the past.

- P. Sen Lares-Chacin: CRT is political and just ideology. Disappointed in the attitude the public speakers came with specifically by coming after specific senators.
- Q. Sen Marin: Understands that there are different opinions but the other senators should vote yes because the majority of our campus are affected by this issue.
