- B. 15 Minute Discussion on Legislative Ideas and Current Initiatives
  - 1. Alexander Stone amended this time to 20 minutes.
  - 2. Senator Moya-Palacios wants to get started with legislative term as soon as possible as it will require much time and effort. The idea of townhalls or open house for senate meetings was brought up. Senator Moya stated to put it in legislation to bind upcoming generations to hold at least two townhalls for the academic year. An expanded career fair was also mentioned, with an emphasis

- on rising seniors being able to show their work. Also wants to bring back senate committee back, to make ad hoc committees permanent.
- 3. Senator Salup-Cid wants an event to have students be more knowledgeable about SGA monthly. Rotating panel of senators to talk about their legislation, so students could learn and provide ideas about townhalls.
- 4. Senator Cruz loved the townhall idea but questioned the format of student engagement. Senator Cruz spoke about how engagement will be for non-traditional students such as working students or students with families.
- 5. Senator Mancuso spoke about targeting demographics that are interested in SGA. Mentioned that FIU does not have enough poster boards and so the ones that are present end up being overrun and disorganized.
- 6. Senator Stone spoke about being inclusive to all students on campus. Think the event should not be held in SGA Chambers as it would be confining and instead believes it should be held in ballroom. Also asked about the Meet Your Dean event and asked about how it will be fleshed out.
- 7. Kaile spoke about how senate leadership will lead this event, but it has not been fleshed out. Spoke about how townhall was an idea, previously discussed.
- 8. Santana Way spoke about social media training that leadership is currently undergoing. Addressed Senator Mancuso posting policy regarding poster boards. Then addressed townhall "State of Student Body Address", addresses from leadership, legislative branch, recruitment, agencies, and bureaus would be carried out. Spoke about copying block schedule from Orientation office. Carer fairs are done through Career and Talent Development and so that department should be discussed by Senator Moya.
- 9. Senator Dawson suggested to scale down rather than scale down as a targeted event would be more beneficial. Heat Maps should be utilized to make the townhalls more targeted.
- 10. Senator Dawson extended motion by 10 minutes, seconded by Senator Mancuso.
- 11. Floor leader Hernandez spoke about Meet Your Dean event, though bigger acknowledged the power of smaller segments. Spoke about sharing more SGA events online. Spoke about timing of events and how they should be diversified to promote inclusion.
- 12. Senator Salup-Cid expressed agreement with small scale coffee hour to promote retention. Spoke about having more than one event a semester.
- 13. Senator Sharma also expressed agreement with a small scale townhall.

- 14. Santana Way spoke about how his duties cover small meetups and that he is open to collaboration with the various branches. Mentioned 'SGA TV' idea.
- 15. Senator Cruz then suggested an ongoing dropbox through social media could improve engagement.
- 16. Senator Stone bounced off Senator Dawson's idea but did not agree with monthly meetings.
- 17. Senator Salup-Cid moved to extend meeting by 10 minutes and seconded by Senator Stone.
- 18. Kaily spoke about how senate is not a programming body. Also, about how collaboration between branches should be increased. Spoke about how collaboration increase will increase the reach of the group.
- 19. Senator Hernandez posed a question to the senate about the meet the dean event.
- 20. Senator Moya responded to the question saying that though the event was a great event and moved to replace the event with the townhall idea.
- 21. Senator Vogel agreed with the small, localized meeting to promote engagement during the meetings.
- 22. Senator Dawson believes that the Meet your dean event should be revamped but not repealed as it serves its own unique purpose.
- 23. Senator Vogel moved to extend meeting by 15 minutes.
- 24. Senator Stone spoke about how the townhall should be worked to fit many different schedules to ensure maximum participation.
- 25. Senator Cruz spoke about not 'biting off more than they can chew' in response to all the ideas being discussed.
- 26. Kaily spoke about how social media has been a main point of discussion in leadership discussions.
- 27. Senator Salup-Cid spoke about setting up a central senate email. Also spoke about gender neutral bathrooms
- 28. Senator Stone addressed a question to Larissa about creating a select email for Housing issues.

A. Brian Levine spoke about how commencement fair and FIU PD active shooter training occurred on same day. Spoke about how university needs to not double book itself and to coordinate. Senate minutes have been being uploaded to Archives and executive board minutes need to be uploaded. Spoke about how agenda needs to be made public.
