- 9. Candidate confirmed.
- C. Confirmation of Deputy Chief of Staff (Eva Galleazzi Bruno)
 - 1. Student body president gave the description of the position, responsible for assisting e-board meetings and staff support
 - 2. The candidate gave a speech, was a Sec of Student Affairs before, aims to promote more opportunities to students, create open communication space at SGA, work on social interaction enhancement through more events.
 - 3. Q&A: candidate answered a question about the event previously conducted; maintaining the individuality and assisting staff, plans to cater to the diverse



population of students; more social events for students; events for online students.

- 4. Motion to vote the candidate in unanimous consent by Sen. Sharma passed.
- D. Five minutes discussion on international students
 - Sen. Sharma raised the issue of housing for international students. Many
 wanted to stay on campus but were placed on waitlists, had to find housing off
 campus. After that were given notification for on-campus housing eligibility
 but already had a lease signed. Request the matter to be addressed as soon as
 possible.
 - 2. Sen. Legoute, also on behalf of other international students. Decided to live on campus as she was by herself, had to move 6 times. Was asked to find an Air BnB. FIU could do a better job to accommodate international students housing needs, FIU officials to be invited.
 - 3. Motion to extend the discussion by 10 min passed.
 - 4. Sen. Campbell: the issue to be escalated as international students are asked to find housing off campus, finding housing is difficult.
 - 5. Sen. Watkins: international students are removed from housing lists/not given opportunity to apply, seniors cannot apply for housing (domestic students as well). International students can't work, have no credit score so have difficulties obtaining off-campus housing. Had an expectation of international students receiving assistance at FIU, however that is not the case, the housing officials do not address the issue.
- Sen. Moya-Palacios: issues were brought up last year (housing, tuition, guidance).
 Resolutions were brought up last year, proposes to bring an international student
 representative to the floor to help address the issue as an official position. Students
 can't work, have immigration paper issues; proposes to work to find a solution
 pathway as some administration members do not assist students.
- Sen. Stone: had conversation with the Director of Housing, the reason for
 international students not being able to access housing is the expansion of student
 body, that created the issue of housing. More dormitories are currently being
 constructed.
- 3. Sen. Mancuso: motion to extend by 10 min passed, not more than 2 min for individual speech.



Most incoming students are domestic students, a dorm for international students is needed as was the case in the past. Considers the international student representative position helpful but will not help solve the issue as different levels of action are required.

- 4. Sen. Minar: about 15 personal accounts from international students regarding the issue, need for solution.
- 5. Sen. Brochinsky: a building at BBC is being leased to Royal Caribbean
- 6. Sen. Mejia: wants to hear more about proposed quick solutions
- 7. Sen. Hernandez: one of the initiatives by the Gov. is DEI funds to be returned to the source which leads to funds being blocked, encourages attendance in person to address the issue.
- 8. Sen. Way: issue affects domestic students as well, need to contact the university officials for short-term and long-term solutions. Find available spaces on campus to be used; work with officials for them to listen to students.
- Motion to extend by 7 min by Sen. LeChapelle.
 Encourages working with other departments and administrators and putting forward a resolution, using surveys, advocate as a group of students with the officials and the Board of Trustees.
- 10. Sen. Watkins: the change was made less than one year ago, first semester of implementation. International students do not have the same opportunities as domestic students, graduate domestic students are not as affected as international students as international students face more difficulties documentation-wise.
- 11. Sen. Dawson: encourages not to put different groups of students against each other, all student groups have difficulties, including international.
- 12. Sen. Mancuso: emphasizes that more student voices are better for looking for solutions, students from the Caribbean may have a better position due to no need for long flights.
- 13. Motion to extend the meeting until 6:10 by Sen. Stone passed. @ senators need to leave at 6-6:05.
- 14. Motion to continue with other points on the agenda passes.

XI. Public Forum

A. 1. Brian Levine: was given short notice of no housing extension at BBC. The Board of Trustees meeting this week at BBC.



Townhall with SGA participation is encouraged, important to address BBC issues.
