IX. Unfinished Business

- A. SB 04 001: Rules of Procedure:
 - 1. Bronchinsky moves to individually read unfriendly amendments and vote: First amendment (remove 3fiii): 2 min discussion, brochinsky wants to rid it, Arzola says we shouldn't rid it, but instead find someone else for lower division senates to talk to. Mancuso says to vote by placard vote passed. 12 aye, 12 nay, abstain 1. Amendment not passed.
 - 2. Second amendment (remove 5bv): motion to go into a 1.5 min discussion passed. Discussion: brochinsky doesn't think senate president should be allowed to raise or lower number of absences. Palacios agrees with brochinsky. Motion to extend by 3 min passed. La Chappell states that if we want to change this, we need to change statues. Gibson says we should keep it as well as



- Mancuso. Motion for reading of statues passed: Section 9001.1.2 read. Motion to vote via placard passed: 3 aye, 20 nay, 2 abstain. Failed.
- 3. Third amendment (to add amendment stated at the bottom of 7c): Motion to 2 min discussion passed. Brochinsky states that this will allow unbiases. Motion to extend by 2 min passed. Cambell disagrees with the amendment, and Cruz agrees, they believe it will take too much time away. Motion to extend by 2 min passed. Mancuso states that there will always be a loophole for bias. Motion to extend by 2 min passed. Motion to vote on add amendment by placard vote passed: 3 aye, 20 nay, 2 abstain, not passed.
- 4. Fourth amendment (remove 7av2): removed
- 5. Fifth amendment: (remove 8aiii) Motion for 4 min discussion passed. Brochinsky states that everyone should have the right to not vote and shouldn't have to explain themselves. Martinez says that you don't have to say personal things, you can just state conflict of interest. Mancuso agrees with Martinez and says reasons for abstaining can be vague. Voting by placard vote passed: 4 aye, 16 nay, 1 abstain. Not passed

A. Discharge:

1. SB 04 003: Sustainability Fair Act: motion to table first item over second failed.



- 1. Senator Vogel moved to bypass the reading the to reading of the title and the amount being allocated, moved was seconded and passed with a 18-7-0 vote
- 2. The new amount is \$2629.61 for the sustainability fair
- 3. Senator Brochinsky stated the amount, the event held bi-annually and how Rules the committee should not vote on amounts. The bill failed with a 2-3-0 vote.
- 4. Senator Stone moved for a seven-minute discussion, motion was seconded and passed. The budget will be just for this semester. Motion to extend by 7 min passed. Brochinksy states that just because no one is using the budget as for this moment, we still shouldnt because its a big part of SGA budget. Stone says that we should find a way to lower the costs.
