- V. Invited Speakers
  - A. Sim Sitzer: Online international junior student in international relations.
    - 1. FIU wrote that tuition for international students was about 350 per credit, but when he started the bill almost doubled for his classes. When he says something to FIU, he states that they changed the information on website to almost double of what it was. He hopes that SGA can help him overcome this problem.

- X. Unfinished Business:
  - A. Senator Brochinsky says that last week only one committee met quorum. Urges leaders to find a time where they can consistently meet quorum. Senator Brochinsky states that you can still meet without quorum, but just not vote. Senator Mancuso votes to extend discussion by 5 min second and passed. #### XI. New Business

- A. S.B. 002 Senate Committees Act:
  - 1. Act was read for the second time. Motion for q/a passed. Senator Mancuso asked what vote is needed for it to pass. 2/3 voted to be put on ballet, 15% student body population that voted in last general election. 750 total votes to ratified. 2/3 of present quorum to pass.



- 2. 5 min discussion by Senator bronchi sky passed. He says the concern is that adding another committee could be too much on scheduled, and quorum will lower every time. Senator Maya-Palacio states that this committee is necessary because international students do not have a strong voice right now. Motion to extend by 2 min denied.
