- XI. New Business
  - A. S.R. 04 005:
    - 1. Form was read. Legoute: this week is international student week, and she says it is a suitable time to act, such as voting. Watkins adds thank you to international students who have spoken up about their problems. Wants to point out that this is just not for international students, it is for the whole student body. Q/A: put both international and upper-class students' students together because they both face similar issues. Stone proposed having a meeting with all the advocators for international and graduate housing. Motion to extend by 2 min passed. Mancuso says that the bill should focus more on international students rather than graduate students. Motion to 10min discussion passed. Broschinsky says that having all upper-class students is too much because underclassmen should be important as well and he wants to postpone the bill. Motion to extend by 10min passed. Andreus and Salup Sid that having upper classmen on this bill is important because many upper classmen cannot work, due to a lot of challenging work to focus on. Broschinsky says that undergraduates are too young, and fresh from high school so they should be showed more consideration. 3 min extension passed.



Salup Sid says that this is not binding yet, and he believes this is a good starting place. La Chapelle says that everyone needs to listen to each other.
