- 3. Sen. Fernando Menendez gave a speech, presented his background and experience for the position, has had a working relationship with Sen. Caseres; involved in organizations in the College of Business

  Sen. Perez gave a speech, presented her background, experiences, and qualifications for the position

  Sen. Jayo-Acuna gave a speech, presented an outline of her experiences and qualifications for the positions, budget management experiences; would like



Sen. François gave a speech, presented her relevant experiences and motivation to get the position

4. 5 min Q&A: Sen. Brochinsky asks what Committees the candidates are on, candidates stated the Committees served

Sen. Lyons asks about the duration of the of financial responsibilities and budget management for the candidates to date, the candidates presented their relevant experiences

Sen. Wagenman moves to extend the Q&A by 2 min, motion passes. Sen. Wagenman asks about priorities for distribution of funds, Sen. Stone makes a point information to clarify the matter, suggests changing the question to priorities for the candidates in office; candidates presented their priorities for serving the Student Body in the office

5. Sen. Brochinsky moves to go into a placard vote, motion passes

Sen. Fernando Menendez: 20 votes

Sen. Perez: 3 votes

Sen. Jayo-Acuna: 2 votes

Sen. François: 9 votes

With 20 votes, Sen. Fernando Menendez is elected to the Finance Committee.

- B. S.R. 5.005 The Sunshine Plan Act: Senator M. Lyons
  - 1. Sen. Lyons read the bill
  - 2. Sen. Lyons made a statement on the purpose of the bill to showcase the work of SGA through social media
  - 3. 5 min Q&A: Sen. Francois asks about video creation individually or as a group, Sen. Lyons: Senators can record in a group, such as CASE/CARTA Sen. Stone clarifies the process of making content for social media Sen. Gudipati: asks whether social media is Instagram, will propose an amendment

Sen. Gowie: asks how the SGA member of the week will be chosen, Sen. Lyons explains the process

Sen. Perez: asks whether it would be beneficial to provide information on Committees, Sen. Stone: clarifies the matter

Sen. Tillias: asks about the process to select SGA members for social media presentation, Sen. Lyons: has been with SGA social media staff, Senators can be contacted when legislation is passed



Sen. Tillias moves to extend the Q&A by 2 min 30 sec, motion passes. Sen. Tillias: asks about the process to work with SGA social media staff, Sen. Lyons clarifies

Sen. Anish Sharma: moves to elapse Q&A and move to voting, Sen. Stone: clarifies the process for voting

- 4. Sen. St. Rose moves for a 5 min discussion, motion passes
  Sen. St. Rose: agrees with the purpose of the resolution, asks for more details
  on the process
  Sen. Jayo-Acuna: appreciates the bill, would like more clarity as well, would
  be happy to support the resolution after clarification
  Sen. Perez: considers the bill important, agrees with the need for more
  information on the process, events for different branches of SGA to get
  together could be helpful, Sen. Lyons: would not like the bill to be too strict
  Sen. Brochinsky: submitted some amendments with Sen. Gudipati, second
  - reading has not taken place and the bill can be discussed further Sen. Krause: agrees with the resolution but makes a point about broad statements included in the bill, the text could be more particular, procedures should be clarified
- 5. Sen. Stone: outlines the options for proceeding, including bypassing the second reading; considers it not being appropriate at this time. Suggests further clarification before passing the bill
- 6. Sen. Fineberg asks for clarification on the process, Sen. Stone clarifies
- 7. Sen. Brochinsky clarifies the process to work on amendments
- 8. Sen. Brochinsky moves to continue with the agenda, motion passes.
- 9. Sen. Lyons thanks the Senators, is open to more discussion and revision of the bill

- 7. Sen. Perez: makes a point about early voting event, suggests an SGA newsletter
- 8. Sen. Marrero: asks about an event and voting on campus being from a different county, makes a point about an EC event
- 9. Sen. Boyo: makes a point about SGA retreat
- 10. Sen. Wagenman: announces an event
- 11. Sen. Lyons: thanks Senators who attended the retreat, open to collaboration on the bill
- 12. Sen. Brochinsky: answers the question from Sen. Marrero on an event; thanks those who joined the retreat
- 13. Sen. Gedeon: absences from the meeting should be communicated in advance
