- 4. Sen. Fineberg moves to suspend the rules and approve the legislation by unanimous consent; rescinded.
- 5. Sen. Jayo-Acuna: moves to suspend the rules and approve the bill by placard vote.
- 6. Sen. Fineberg: moves to go into roll call vote.
- 7. Sen. Boyo: moves for a discussion, motion fails.
- 8. Previous motions rescinded. Sen. Fineberg moves for unanimous consent for a roll call vote, motion passes. With 39 yes, 3 no, 0 abstentions the bill passes.
