 - A. Appointment of Secretary of Student Affairs: John Casso
 - 1. Sen. Stone read the role description
 - 2. Candidate gave a speech, gave an outline of his goals in the position, would like to focus on mental health, wellness, housing, dining, commuter student experiences
 - 3. 5 min Q&A: Sen. Tillias asks about improvement of the current housing and advocating for students living on campus, candidate: understands the issue, plans to work with administration
 - Sen. Gudipati: asks about the plans for commuter students, candidate: plans to do a poll to collect opinions, help students express their needs



Sen. Francois: asks about cooperation with other senators, candidate: considers collaboration to be the most important, open to collaborate Sen. Mata: asks about events the candidate plans to have, candidate: will look into that, main focus for the moment is transparency Sen. Jayo-Acuna moves to extend Q&A by 2 min 30 sec, Sen. Fineberg: according to Rules, extension is only possible through suspension of the Rules. Sen. Stone: point is valid, motion will not be recognized. Sen. Brochinsky: moves to enter a 10-min discussion, motion fails.

- 4. Sen. Fineberg moves to approve the Candidate by unanimous consent. With no objections, the Candidate is confirmed.

Sen. Jayo-Acuna: asks about the specific plans in the position, the candidate plans to maintain order and ensure office hours are held, responsibilities according to the Statutes

Sen. Gedeon: asks about the responsibilities according to the Statutes, candidate: plans to represent the student voices, provide justice
Sen. Touissant: asks about conflict resolution within SGA, candidate: goal to find a resolution, considers it her job to hold officials accountable
Sen. Anish Sharma moves to approve the Candidate with unanimous consent, with no objections the Candidate is confirmed.
