 - A. Senate Rules of Procedure (R.O.P.) Presentation

Gave a summary of edits made to rules of procedure. Senate leadership must meet with advisor once a week. Send agendas for meetings 24hrs prior. Sending minutes to committee members 24hrs prior to meetings. Senators select top preferences and assignments should be within 4 weeks of leadership elections. Senators must complete 3 office hours, senate meetings, 1 time with the dean per semester. Attendance is mandatory for special meetings. Discussion time is now up to 2 10min discussion times up to speaker's discretion or majority vote. Voting: if you abstain, you need to provide a reason why and must be recorded. Committees meeting: option to hold biweekly meetings during Fall/Spring. Reports: if both chair and vice chair are absent, the senate's provides officer delivers the report. Voting confirmations: removed unanimous consent. Public forum: if there is a member of the public in a meeting, they have priority, also limited time and number of speakers. Guest rep meeting: caps on



representatives per organization or issue. Vacancy replacement: interviewers may use different questions to allow more specific questions. Procedures of legislation: legislation sent to floor leader, tempe, advisor. As well as 24hr prior. Amendments: speaker notifies senate on amendments submitted after meeting; legislature can be referred to a committee for further review. Office hours: completed in person, or online with floor leader permission; You can do it on other campuses; other SGA events can be an exception as long as its approved; prohibits office hours during senate meeting; disputes with hours resolved by floor leader. XI. New Business

A. Speaker Vacancy:

- i. Senator Mata nominates Barriga, Caseres seconds, Barriga accepts.
- ii. Relinquished chair rights to Caseres. Caseres relinquishes to Gedeon. Caseres nominates himself.
- iii. Senator Tillias nominates Brochinsky, he accepts.
- iv. Barriga Speech: Very deep understanding of legislative process and will make sure that everyone is on track and is doing well. She has served as a vice chair and a senator which has led her to understand what each committee needs.
- v. Caseres Speech: He will ensure smooth operations and focus. He works with a capable committee which will lead him to focus on the position. Wants everyone to feel heard, focusing on collaboration. Has serves as finance director, chapter president of sigma phi epsilon and works with dean of business college.
- vi. Brochinsky Speech: Serves as chair of rules which allowed him to see all of legislation, also chair of BBC, Vice chair on rules of committee. Makes sure everything is done in a proper and right way.
- vii. Q/A: Gudipati asks if legislation needs to be assigned to a committee. Barriga, if it is something student wants, it will be assigned to a committee. Caseres, again, if it is something that benefits the students as a whole. Brochinsky says he would only deny it if it went against something in the document or rules.
- viii. Senator Toussaint asks if political ideas can be discussed in senate meetings. Brochinsky says that if a senator wants to bring something political in, the senate as a whole will decide. Caseres says that if it is an issue that affects students, yes. Barriga says that if it affects the student, it is important and should be talked about.
- ix. Tillian asked what is something that needs improvement. Caseres says that the structure that Stone brought was great, and what needs work on is doing anything on time. Barriga wants to ensure some sort of workshop for writing legislature, and something that would be benefitable to change is that everything is sent in in an orderly manner. Brochinsky states that he likes the order that was kept; something he wants to change is the efficiency of agendas, legislation, responses, etc.
- x. Senator François moves to extend by 2 min 30 sec, Senator Tillias seconds.



- xi. Senator Gowie asks what sets you apart from nominees. Brochinsky says that he knows the documents and procedures very deeply. Barriga states that she has done the meet your dean event and that has led to students being able to talk to the dean. Also, she understands the role of what is necessary for speaker, she is highly organized and a perfectionist. Caseres states that his current committee is great, so he can leave his position safe and focus on his next role as well as bring consistency.
- xii. Motion to extend by 1 min by Mata fails.
- xiii. Senator Tillias motions to 5 min discussion period, Senator François seconds.
 - 1. Discussion period: Mata says that we should make our pro tempore the speaker to make it smoother transition.
 - 2. Tillias says that whoever it is can learn the position just like anyone else can.
 - 3. Acuna endorses Barriga.
 - 4. Krause states that all candidates have held leadership positions, and we should look beyond current positions.
