IV. Approval of Last Meeting Minutes

A. November 4th, 2024

Sen. Gudipati moves to approve the minutes by unanimous consent, motion passes.

V. Adoption of the Agenda

Sen. Brochinsky moves to add a Dining at BBC bill to the new business. Sen. Stone recommends not to approve since Shop FIU members would like to meet the bill sponsors. Shop FIU members are present.

Shop FIU member: participation was recommended in the discussion on dining options at BBC.

Sen. Brochinsky amends the motion to add the item to the new business with floor rights for the Shop FIU members in the public forum.

Sen. Stone recognizes the motion to add Shop FIU members as speakers, motion to add the bill to be added later.

Sen. Fineberg: makes a point about Shop FIU members presentation and potentially changing calculus.

Motion to add Shop FIU members as invited speakers passes.

VI. Invited Speakers

- A. 1. Shop FIU member: makes a point about dining services at FIU; analysis is continuously conducted to provide best quality services. Fiscal responsibilities need to be upheld; operation hours are targeted to better serve the students. Food brands need numbers to operate on campus, including number of students served. Many students work in the dining facilities and feedback from students is being collected. Marketing efforts have been made, including promoting variety. Some vendors may not come to BBC due to low student numbers.
 - 2. 5 min Q&A: Sen. Brochinsky: asks about attempts to change the hours, Shop FIU member: in the beginning of the semester hours are assessed and set, taking into account the class schedule

Sen. St. Rose: asks about the latest time the last restaurants close and additional services, Shop FIU member: provided the hours and information on services



Sen. Touissant: asks about consideration for 6 pm to midnight food options at BBC, Shop FIU member: has not been considered due to low traffic, the matter has been tested, students may use residential kitchens

Sen. Jayo-Acuna moves to extend the Q&A by 5 min, motion passes.

Sen. Jayo-Acuna makes a point about late dining options and a survey conducted where students commented on lack of availability of food options, asks what surveys have been examined on the matter. Shop FIU member: surveys are conducted a few times a year, open to looking into the matter

Sen. Lucas Menendez asks about the EC kitchen use, Shop FIU member: responded on the matter; discussion with the Vicky Café took place, continuous work to bring more services is ongoing

Sen. Lyons: asks about faculty involvement, Shop FIU: yes, faculty and staff are involved

Sen. Stone: makes a point about the need for more conversation on the matter.

Sen. Brochinsky moves to add the SR5 007 to the agenda, motion fails.
