- X. Unfinished Business
  - A. S.R. 05 007 Food at BBC
    - 1. Sen. Brochinsky presented the bill
    - Sen. Jayo-Acuna made a comment on limited dining options at BBC according to the survey results, need to expand options for students with diverse dietary needs
    - 3. Sen. Gedeon made a comment on ensuring that dietary needs of students are made over profits
    - 4. Sen. Brochinsky: dietary needs is one of the pressing priorities, many students are dissatisfied with options and hours
    - 5 min Q&A: Sen. Touissant: agrees with the resolution, asks about possible suggestions to increase food traffic. Sen. Brochinsky: suggests to increase classes

Sen. Caseres: asks about next steps in the process if the bill is passed and plans to work with Shop FIU, Sen. Brochinsky: BBC-specific representation for Shop FIU was not invited, some concerns get addressed according to feedback from students

Sen. Stone: asks about a meeting with Shop FIU, Sen. Brochinsky: plans to reach out to Shop FIU representatives



Sen. Barriga: asks about possible gains from the legislation, Sen. Brochinsky: better interaction with Shop FIU and addressing student feedback Sen. Peterson: asks about the focus on improving the existing option vs. adding more options, Sen. Brochinsky: both options are possible depending on feasibility

Sen. St. Rose: asks whether anything can be implemented in the short term, Sen. Brochinsky: currently there is no mechanism for collecting student feedback, no menu is currently present, these improvements can be implemented quickly

Sen. Lyons: moves to extend the Q&A by 1 min 30 sec, amended to 2 min, motion passes

Sen. Lyons: agrees with the bill, asks about potential refusal of implementation, Sen. Brochinsky: feedback from students should be acknowledged

Sen. Cambron: asks about calculation of operation hours, Sen. Brochinsky: explains

Sen. Gowie: asks whether students would like to expand options or not interested in current ones, Sen. Brochinsky: fatigue from lack of variety seems to be present; Sen. Gowie asks about raising awareness among students regarding Shop FIU policies, Sen. Brochinsky: explains the strategy

- 6. Sen. Brochinsky moves to open a discussion, motion passes.
- 7. 10-min discussion: Sen. Brochinsky: there is no way for Shop FIU to get student feedback at BBC at the moment; there is no menu and if menu is present, it may be wrong; options are limited

Sen. St. Rose: went on a tour of the dining area, surveys available at MMC for student feedback are not available at BBC

Sen. Francois: asks what else is on the plan besides improving the foot traffic, Sen. Brochinsky: expanding classes, bus availability, working with the administration to improve the campus

Sen. Hernandez: the resolution is a good to start the conversation, generally supports it

Sen. Peterson: the matter is particularly important for out-of-state students who have no family locally

Sen. Touissant: students who don't have access to transportation for offcampus food and can't cook may face particularly serious issues



Sen. Francois: generally agrees with the bill, proposes an option that is open late

Sen. Jayo-Acuna: agrees with a lot of points made, options have been limited for a long time, the needs of students need to be made

  - 1. Sen. St. Rose presented the resolution
  - 2. Sen. St. Rose: explains the purpose of the bill, students would like a chance to meet their representatives and voice concerns
  - Sen. Barriga: makes a comment on the cost of organizing the event if the
    event is a designated occurrence, Sen. St. Rose: if the event becomes a
    designated occurrence, could look into it; the budget changes; open to
    friendly amendments
  - 4. 5 min Q&A: Sen. Caseres: makes a comment about the importance of informing the Senate about the budget
    - Sen. Cambron: asks why the resolution was proposed rather than organizing events, Sen. St. Rose: for the purpose of guidelines and for students to be informed that their concerns are acknowledged
    - Sen. Boyo: asks about the timing of the event and focus on Business students only, Sen. St. Rose: for now, the event is open to only Business students
  - 5. Sen. Brochinsky moves for a 10-min discussion, motion fails
  - 6. Sen. François: moves for a 5 min discussion, motion passes
  - 7. 5-min discussion: Sen. Sutton: likes the proposed resolution, considers opening it to other schools
    - Sen. Brochinsky: makes a point about the purpose of proposing a resolution for Business students, being appropriate and potential expansion to other students



Sen. Touissant: considers it appropriate to include students who are considering changing their major or adding a minor, or having questions related to Business school, beneficial to promote communication Sen. St. Rose: acknowledges the possibility of students from other schools attending the event, open to expansion

# B. S.B. 05 008: IAC Tabling Bill.

- 1. Sen. Lyons presents the bill
- 2. Sen. Lyons presents the purpose of the bill, can be used for office hours as well
- 3. Sen. Krause makes a point about a possibility of tabling counting as office hours and equal distribution of tabling workload
- 4. 5 min Q&A: Sen. Stone: makes a comment about formatting of the bill



Sen. Francois: asks whether it includes individual tabling, Sen. Lyons: yes Sen. Gedeon: makes a comment about visibility

Sen. Tillias: makes a point about formatting, the registration process for tabling, and time commitment

Sen. Stone: asks about tabling being a requirement and the course of action if nobody signs up, Sen. Tillias: given the size of the Senate the possibility should be unlikely, bill provides opportunity for tracking of activities and tabling substituting for office hours, tabling is a requirement Sen. Brochinsky asks what committee the bill went through, bill amends ROP; Sen. Stone: explains

- 5. Sen. Gowie moves to extend Q&A by 2 min, motion passes Sen. Gowie: asks what happens if there is not enough time for everyone to do tabling during the semester, Sen. Krause: there are enough tabling and other types of events, Senators can reach out and an opportunity can be created; no increased time requirement proposed by the bill. Sen. Gowie: asks about phrasing of tabling in terms of hours vs. sessions, Sen. Gedeon: explains
- 6. Sen. St. Rose moves for a 10-min discussion, motion passes
- 7. 10-min discussion: Sen. St. Rose: supports the bill since the experience of no one being available for tabling can be frustrating
  Sen. Stone: makes a comment against making more requirements for Senators

Sen. Jayo-Acuna: agrees with Sen. Stone as the bill puts additional requirements in conflicts with the current responsibilities, activities should not be mandated

Sen. Gowie: makes a point about alternatives to tabling, Sen. Stone: Senators can sign up for tabling voluntarily

Sen. Gowie: makes a point about availability

Sen. Krause: agrees that Senators should participate based on initiative, however, it has not been the case, so the requirement was proposed Sen. Tillias: office hours requirement can be satisfied by doing tabling, tabling is an opportunity to represent SGA

Sen. Touissant: considers the requirement to be necessary to distribute the workload equally, Senators get paid for serving at SGA and it is commitment that comes with certain expectations

Sen. Stone: makes a point about equal distribution of workload



- 8. Sen. Barriga moves to extend the discussion by 3 min, motion passes Sen. Romeo: makes a point of clarification regarding office hours, Sen. Lyons: clarifies, no additional requirement is created Sen. Allen: same Senators may be doing the tabling and more towards the end of the semester, Sen. Stone: no questions should be asked during the discussion
  - Sen. Gudipati: supports the bill since tabling is a part of the office hours
- 9. Sen. Brochinsky moves to extend the discussion by 4 minutes, motion fails
- 10. Sen. Anish Sharma: moves for a roll call vote
- 11. Sen. Cambron: makes a point about the bill going to the Rules Committee
- 12. Sen. Stone suggests a motion to table the bill until the next semester
- 13. Sen. Tillias makes a point of clarification regarding the process of reviewing the bill
- 14. Sen. Brochinsky moves to send the bill to the Rules Committee, motion passes.
- 15. Sen. Lyons asks about subsequent readings, Sen. Stone clarifies.

- 6. Sen. Stone: encourages the comments for the latest bill to be presented in the next discussion
- 7. Sen. Anish Sharma gives a speech regarding his upcoming graduation, thanks the Senators for the work, wishes the Senators the best
- 8. Sen. Salup-Cid makes a speech due to his upcoming graduation: thanks the Senators, encourages the Senators to engage with the student body
- 9. Sen. Stone: expresses appreciation for graduating Senators
