All teams will participate in a 3-game regular season followed by playoffs
CoRec, Mens, Womens
All games will be played at the North Turf Field (Located next to PG3)
Teams will consist of 11 players on the field at a time. A minimum of 8 players are needed to start the game.
Co-Rec teams are required to have at least 3 of each gender present on the field at all times. Players must wear similarly colored team jerseys. If teams do not have team jerseys, mesh
pullovers will be issued. Bring alternate jerseys each game!
Metal cleats may not be worn.
Intramural Sports will provide soccer balls. Participants may use their own ball as long as both captains agree.
Teams will participate in a 50-minute game. The game will consist of two 25-minute halves, with a running clock. No stoppage time will be added.
NO SLIDE TACKLING IS PERMITTED
This 11 v 11 soccer league does enforce offsides
All teams qualify for playoffs regardless of their record as long as they have a 2.5 Sportsmanship Rating at the end of the regular season.
Intramural Sports Championship T-shirts will be awarded to the winning team in each league!
GAME TIME IS FORFEIT TIME
A team forfeits when they fail to have any players legally signed in and properly attired to play at the scheduled game time. If a team has less than the minimum number of players, but at least one person legally signed in and properly attired to play, a team will be given ten minutes from scheduled game time to reach the minimum number of players needed to begin a contest. Participants will not be given warm-up time for showing up after scheduled game time. Please refer to the IM Sports Handbook for more information.
