GAME:	Cornhole is played with two teams of two players throwing fabric bean bags at a raised, angled board with a hole in its far end. The goal of the game is to score points by either landing a bag on the board (one point) or putting a bag through the hole (three points).
	Each match is best 2 out of 3 games. Each match has a total time limit of 30 minutes.
	The game is won when a team scores 21 points or more. Teams do NOT need to score exactly 21 points. There is NO PENALTY for going over 21.
	In the event of a third game, the score will go to 15 points instead of 21.

	GAME TIME IS FORFEIT TIME
FORFEITS:	A team forfeits when they fail to have any players legally signed in and properly attired to play at the scheduled game time. If a team has less than the minimum number of players, but at least one person legally signed in and properly attired to play, a team will be given ten minutes from scheduled game time to reach the minimum number of players needed to begin a contest. Participants will not be given warm-up time for showing up after scheduled game time. Please refer to the IM Sports Handbook for more information.
