NUMBER OF PLAYERS:	Teams will consist of 1 player
GAME:	A game is won by the player first scoring 11 points unless both players score 10 points. If both players are tied at 10 points, the game is won by the first player subsequently gaining a lead of two points. The game will be capped at a maximum of 15 points. A match will consist of the best of 3 out of 5 games.
	The Tournament layout will be determined based on the number of participants registered by the deadline. Here are the different tournament formats that may be played:

CHAMPIONSHIPS:	Intramural Sports Championship T-shirts will be awarded to the winning team in each league!
	GAME TIME IS FORFEIT TIME
FORFEITS:	A team forfeits when they fail to have any players legally signed in and properly attired to play at the scheduled game time. If a team has less than the minimum number of players, but at least one person legally signed in and properly attired to play, a team will be given ten minutes from scheduled game time to reach the minimum number of players needed to begin a contest. Participants will not be given warm-up time for showing up after scheduled game time. Please refer to the IM Sports Handbook for more information.
